



FUKUI 2 DAYS - Tranquility of Mind

DAY 1

10:00 AM Arriving at Fukui Station

Depart from Osaka Station around 7:30 AM or from Kanazawa Station around 9:00 AM to get to Fukui Station. **Use the Hokuriku One-way Ticket from Osaka or Kyoto and a single-ride ticket or the Kansai Hokuriku Area Pass from Kanazawa station.

Take a train, bus or a taxi to Maruoka Castle.

11:00 AM Arriving at Maruoka Castle

Explore Japan's oldest existing castle keep, enjoy the view from the top, and take a stroll around the castle grounds.

**Use the Have Fun in Fukui 1 Week Free Pass for Maruoka Castle admission.

Have lunch near Maruoka Castle or return to Fukui City to enjoy local cuisine. Head towards Eiheiji Hakujukan by bus.

2:00 PM Check-in at Eiheiji Hakujukan Settle in and rest.

3:00 PM Visit to Eiheiji Temple

Eihei-ji is one of the two main temples of the Sōtō school of Zen Buddhism, the largest single religious denomination in Japan. Visit a Zen dojo with over 700 years of history and tradition.

6:00 PM Dinner (Shojin Ryori)

Enjoy a peaceful and healthy Shojin Ryori (Buddhist vegetarian cuisine) dinner in a serene atmosphere.

Relax and unwind at Eiheiji Hakujukan.

DAY 2

8:00 AM Breakfast at Eiheiji Hakujukan (Shojin Ryori)

Check out and head to the Eiheiji-guchi Station (10 mins by car or on foot). Board the Echizen Railway and travel from Eiheiji-guchi Station to Katsuyama Station (30 mins)

**Use the Have Fun in Fukui 1 Week Free Pass for unlimited use on all the Echizen Railway Lines.

When arriving at Katsuyama Station, transfer to a taxi to visit the Great Buddha of Echizen (bus or 10 mins by taxi)

10:00 AM Tour the Great Buddha of Echizen Walk around the grounds and admire the 17-meter tall Buddha statue.

Travel to the Dinosaur Museum (10 mins by taxi)

11:30 AM Visit the Fukui Prefectural Dinosaur Museum

Enjoy the impressive dinosaur exhibits and learn about fossil excavation.

**Use the Have Fun in Fukui 1 Week Free Pass for admission.

Have lunch at a nearby restaurant.

Head back to Katsuyama Station (10 mins by taxi) Board the Echizen Railway and travel from Katsuyama Station to Fukui Station (apx. 1 hour)



4:00 PM Arriving at Fukui Station

Spend time shopping for souvenirs or relaxing at a café near the station.

FUKUI 2 DAYS - Scenery and Gastronomy

DAY 1

10:00 AM Arriving at Tsuruga StationDepart from Osaka Station around 7:30 AM or Kanazawa Station around 9:00 AM to get to Tsuruga Station.

10:30 AM Visit Kehi ShrineStroll from Tsuruga Station to Kehi Shrine and explore this historical site.

12:30 PM Lunch at Nihonkai Sakana Machi (by local bus, approx. 20 minutes)
Take a local bus to enjoy fresh seafood at this popular market.

2:00 PM Take the bus to Kanegasaki Shrine (20 minutes by bus)

3:30 PM Take a taxi to the Rainbow Line Mountain Park (40 minutes)
Use a taxi to reach the Rainbow Line,

where you can enjoy a panoramic view of the Sea of Japan and the Five Lakes of Mikata from the mountaintop park.

Check in at the Hotel Granbinario Tsuruga

7:00 PM Dinner: Sauce Katsudon at Europe-ken (near Tsuruga Station) Enjoy the famous local dish, Sauce Katsudon, at Europe-ken.

Return to the hotel, relax and unwind after your day of sightseeing.









DAY 2

9:00 AM Check out and go to Tsuruga Station

Take the Hokuriku Shinkansen to Fukui, then board the Echizen Railway to Katsuyama station.

**Use the Have Fun in Fukui 1 Week Free Pass for unlimited use on all the Echizen Railway Lines.

10:30 AM Visit the Echizen Daibutsu

Walk or cycle to the impressive Echizen Daibutsu, and explore the area around this huge Buddha statue.

Have lunch at a nearby restaurant.

2:00 PM Visit the Fukui Prefectural Dinosaur Museum

Spend about two hours at this world-class museum, learning about dinosaurs and viewing fascinating exhibits.

Return to Fukui Station by train

5:00 PM Dinner: Soba at Fukui Station

Enjoy Fukui's famous soba noodles for dinner or alternatively, you can explore restaurants near Fukui station.

ITINERARY

Go to Tokyo Station. Transfer to Kanazawa via the Hokuriku Shinkansen (Kagayaki) using the Hokuriku Arch Pass. (Travel time 150min.)

Upon arrival, transfer to your accommodation on your own. Free time - Whole day.

FUKUI

Start your day by going to Kanazawa Station and taking the JR train to Awara Onsen Station, which will take about 1 hour by limited express. Once you arrive at Awara Onsen Station, drop off your luggage at the Grandia Housen Hotel. You can reach the hotel by walking for about 10 minutes or using the hotel shuttle bus. After that, explore Awara Yunomachi by leisurely strolling around the town, enjoying foot baths, and browsing local shops. For lunch, head to a local restaurant in Awara Onsen and try some regional specialties. Next, take the bus to Tojinbo, which will take about 40 minutes, and visit the scenic cliffs known for their rugged, dramatic coastline. Then, take the bus to Mikuni Minato Town, which will take about 15 minutes, and explore the traditional townscape of Mikuni Minato, a historic port town. To end the day, take the bus back to Awara Onsen and proceed to check in your hotel for a relaxing evening in the hot springs. Enjoy a traditional Japanese dinner featuring Echizen crab at the hotel and take a peaceful evening walk around the quiet Awara Onsen town or visit more foot baths.

Day 8 FUKUI Day 4 FUKUI

Depart from Awara Onsen Station using the Echizen Railway, then transfer to Katsuyama Station. Upon arrival, walk or rent a bicycle to reach Echizen Daibutsu. Visit Echizen Daibutsu and explore the area around the giant Buddha statue. Walk or cycle to the Fukui Prefectural Dinosaur Museum and spend time exploring the Fukui Prefectural Dinosaur Museum. Have lunch near the Dinosaur Museum.

Head to Eiheiji using the Echizen Railway and a bus. Visit Eiheiji Temple and walk through the vast grounds. Head to your accommodation, either Eiheiji Hakujukan or a hotel near Fukui Station.

Day 9 FUKUI - KYOTO
